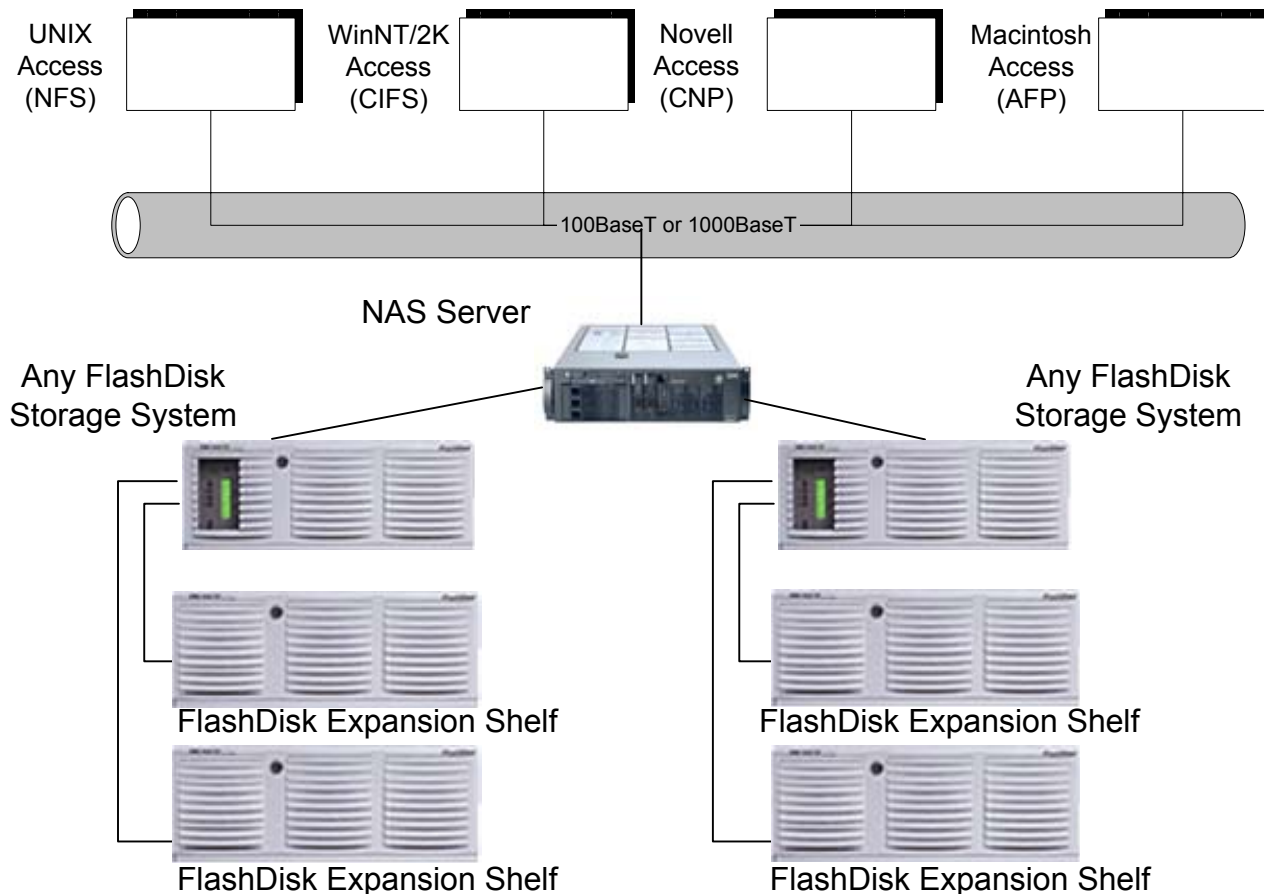


Network Attached Storage (NAS) FlashNAS With Expansion Shelves
